In order to perform directive illocutionary acts politeness strategy aims to help the speaker to achieve the goal of his or her utterance. The result of the study shows that the data contain four strategies of politeness strategy, they are bald of record, bald of record, positive politeness and negative politeness when uttering fourteen kinds of directive illocutionary acts.
