

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter explains the conclusion and suggestion of this research.

5.1. Conclusion

In accordance with the findings and discussion in the Chapter IV, the researcher finally could obtain the conclusion. Firstly, after doing treatment by applying the events chain strategy, and implemented it into statistical analysis, the researcher found that t_{list} is smaller than t_{count} or $0.15 > 0.7$. It means that the hypothesis is acceptable. So, there is a significant result/ students' ability in writing narrative text by using chains strategy. It is effective to develop students' ability in narrative text. Secondly, the appropriate strategy used for teaching writing skill is very important to help students to understand the teaching materials.

5.2. Suggestion

There are some suggestions could be followed for the sake of the perfection of this research. These suggestions are elaborated in the following items:

1. Every teacher should be able to see students' characters, including their mood feeling in the class. The teacher is escaped for using appropriate strategies to change their feeling to being well.
2. As a part of productive skill, students need special skill toward writing skill. So, the teacher should not ignore brainstorming activity as the first step to collect ideas. For that, the teacher escaped to use concept mapping strategy to teach writing skill.
3. Research instrument used for two variables are events chain strategy and narrative text is necessary to be created within another instrument such as observation and interview. It is meant for covering weaknesses acquired into written instrument.

4. For the further research, this research escaped could give great contribution for other to develop strategy in another skill.

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
