Employees Payroll Accounting System of Gorontalo Islamic Hospital (RSIG) had some weaknesses, such as the recording of financial transactions related to employees' payroll and its manual payroll caused a slow process. The study aimed to find out how employees' payroll accounting system done at RSIG, which included documents used, the accounting records used, the associated function, the procedure used, and the flow chart used.
