This chapter presents the conclusion and suggestion as the final result of this research entitled “Irony Analysis in Stephenie Meyer’s Novel *“Twilight”*”, consider to the data analysis and data interpretation in the previous study.

Conclusion

Based on the data analysis and the discussion of this research, the researcher concludes that, there are 12 verbal irony and 10 situational irony in Stephenie Meyer’s novel *“Twilight”*. This research uses structural as the basic instruction in analyzing.

After collect the data I am find out 12 verbal irony. Almost all the data of verbal irony always say something which different with reality or it has opposite meaning with our statement. There is one story in novel *“Twilight”* contain verbal irony that has function as a humor goals. Also, there are three stories in novel *“Twilight”* that categorize into verbal irony that has a function as instructional goals or criticize someone or something. All the data that categorize into verbal irony analyzing by Abrams’s theory. The function of verbal irony as a social function grounded on Litmann and May’s Theory.

There are 10 data in novel *“Twilight”* that classify on situational irony. Situational irony divides into five different situations namely Irony of Simple Incongruity, Irony of Events, Dramatic Irony, Irony of Self-Betrayal, and Irony of Dilemma. All of situational irony includes in situational irony of simple incongruity. There are eight stories in novel *“Twilight”* includes on Situational

Irony of Events. The story that categorize into Situational Irony of Self-Betrayal is one story. There is one story that classify on Situational Irony of Dilemma. There is no Dramatic Irony that contain in novel "*Twilight*".

I am as the researcher make conclude that there are verbal irony and situational irony in novel "*Twilight*". In this novel, the author uses more verbal irony than situational irony. Hence, the problem statement in chapter one can be answered.

Suggestion

In this research I would like to give the present study offers some suggestions. The suggestions will explain below:

1. This study does not include all the elements or kinds of figurative language. This study only focus analyze irony especially the kinds of irony in novel. While, there are many kinds of figurative language that contain in literary work that is still not in the analysis. For that the reader or the students can continue the analysis to other kinds of figurative language as research material. So, students can interest to learn literature.
2. This research can be useful for students and teacher or lecturer. In the content of research study, this research can be references for the students that interest in doing a research about literature. This is present some theory and methodology that can guide the next researcher for doing their research. Then I would like to recommend the students to do a research from other kinds of irony. Also they can be analyzing it in another works of Stephenie Meyer like *New Moon*, *Eclipse*, and *Breaking Dawn*.
