## **CHAPTER V**

## **CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS**

Chapter five presented about some conclusions I could take according to the result of my research, and also some suggestions I would give in relation with my research and for English education.

## Conclusions

From the result of this research, in which  $t_{count} > t_{tab}$  or 3,68> 2,0129, I can conclude that Ruckzuck game as a method of teaching can significantly improve students' speaking ability. it could be viewed from the increase of percentage before and after the game application. After giving the treatment, speaking skills of the whole students were improved from 54,16 to 63,3%. It indicates that Ruckzuck is a good game to be applied in the class for speaking improvement. In addition, this game is more effective for students with many vocabularies mastery. This is because vocabularies are used often through this game so practically its give positive influence for speaking improvement.

## Suggestions

Relating about the game as method of teaching, the game in this research can be considered to be used in teaching English. This game can make class more competitive. Manage class well, because Ruckzuck game could not be applied in the class with larger students; no more than 25 students will be good class to apply. In addition, tell students many words so the game can be conducted successfully, because they will describe a word given by using many words and explanations. This game will support the increase of speaking skill and also vocabulary mastery. Considering that this game can give significant advantages to speaking skill, I also suggest that this game could be used not only at eleventh grade, but also other class and even in junior high school, under good arrangement by teacher. Considering this suggestion, it would be better if related research about ruckzuck game is conducted in different level of class, for example junior high school, and with different of tense. Besides, this game is still new, Ruckzuck can be introduced as good method in schools.
