



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ABSTRACT

Minton Pahabu (Student ID 8414 10 013; The Influencing Factors of Medication Disobeying of TB Patient in Puskesmas Dungaliyo, 2014).

Tuberculosis (TBC) is one of the killing diseases in the world, particularly found in developing countries, that needs a specific medication treatment. According to the preliminary survey in Puskesmas Dungaliyo, there are still disobeying patients in TB treatment. This research aims at investigating the influencing factors of the disobeying of TB patients in Puskesmas Dungaliyo.

This is a correlational descriptive research using cross sectional study approach. The population and sample is all the TB patients in Puskesmas Dungaliyo up to September 2014 consist of 34 patients. The sample is determined by total sampling technique. Data is obtained by questionnaire and analyzed by chi-square test.

The result shows that knowledge, educational background, and income had a significant correlation with the disobeying of TB patients, and each of the significance value were knowledge ($p=0.000$), educational background ($p=0.000$), and income ($p=0.040$).

The result above leads to a conclusion that knowledge, educational background, and income have significant correlation toward the medication disobeying of TB patients in Puskesmas Dungaliyo, Therefore, it is suggested that the medical staff at Puskesmas Dungaliyo can be able to improve the patients' obeying toward giving information and counseling about the TB treatment.
