

ABSTRACT

The family support is a support in form of attention, emotion, and information which is given by member of family. The aggressive behavior can be either physical or verbal behavior. The research aimed at investigating the relation between family support and adolescent aggressive behavior at class XI of SMA Negeri 1 Telaga of Gorontalo district.

The research applied analytic observational method by having cross sectional approach. The total samples were 75 respondents gained through random sampling technique. The instrument of research was questionnaire.

The univariat result showed that the respondents who had lack of family support were 29 respondents (42,0%) and those who had aggressive behavior were 39 respondents (56,6%). The result of statistical test using chi-square test gained the value of $p=0,000$ means there is relation between family support and adolescent aggressive behavior at class XI of SMA Negeri 1 Telaga of Gorontalo district.

It can be concluded that there is relation between family support and adolescent behavior at class XI of SMA Negeri 1 Telaga of Gorontalo district. Therefore, it is suggested for family to pay and give more support to the children and for the students to be better in behavior.
