

ABSTRACT

Laleda Sulastri, 2014. The Relationship of Supervision and Nurses' Performance in Doing Nursing Care at MPKP Room of Regional Public Hospital of Prof. Dr. H. Aloi Saboe of Gorontalo City. Skripsi, Department of Nursing, Faculty of Health and Sport Sciences, Universitas Negeri Gorontalo. The principal supervisor was dr. Zuhriana K. Yusuf, M.Kes and the co-supervisor was Abdul Wahab Pakaya, S.Kep, Ns, MM.

Supervision is a direct observation to the implementation of routinely activity which is needed by the nurses in achieving a good performance. Based on the survey gained from MPKP Room of Regional Public Hospital of Prof. Dr. H. Aloi saboe of Gorontalo city, the process of supervision is conducted once in a week. The research aimed at investigating the relationship between supervision and nurses' performance in doing nursing care at MPKP Room of Regional Public Hospital of Prof. Dr. H. Aloi Saboe of Gorontalo city.

The method of research was non experimental correlation descriptive by having cross sectional approach. The population and the samples of research were 26 nurses who were inservice at MPKP Room of Regional Public Hospital of Prof. Dr. H. Aloi Saboe of Gorontalo city. The samples were gained through saturation sampling technique. The technique of data analysis was Fisher test.

The research result showed that there was significant relationship between supervision held the head of room as director, supervisor, and assessor and nurses' performance in doing nursing care with significance value alternately director as $p = 0,001$, supervisor as $p = 0,000$ and assessor as $p = 0,001$.

It can be concluded that there was significant relationship between supervision held the head of room as director, supervisor, and assessor and nurses' performance in doing nursing care at MPKP Room of Regional Public Hospital of Prof. Dr. H. Aloi Saboe of Gorontalo city. It suggests that the hospital can increase the nursing management particularly the implementation of supervision.
