

ABSTRACT

Immunization is a way to actively improve the immunity toward an antigen. The role of parents in promoting the baby's health from 0-11 months is important in completing the basic immunization in particular. This research aims at investigating factors related to the completeness of basic immunization to babies at the age of 9-12 months in the working area of Puskesmas Toto Utara, Tilongkabila sub-district of Bone Bolango district.

This is a descriptive correlation research by applying cross sectional study approach. The samples are 87 mothers who have 9-12 months babies, determined by Stratified Random Sampling. Data are obtained through questionnaire, and analyzed by Chi Square test and Multiple Logistic Regressions.

The result shows that the factors related to the completeness of basic immunization were educational background (0.000), knowledge (0.000), attitude (0.000), occupy (0.000), and family support (0.000). The dominant factor was knowledge, with the probability value 0.373.

It is recommended for the nurses to improve the health service quality, and work on health promotions such as social support in improving the health education, giving motivation in using the health service, especially immunization. Parents are also need to be participated by giving complete immunization for the babies.
