

## ABSTRACT

**Zulfadli Desyawanto. 2015.** The Relationship between Personality Type and Satisfaction Level of Interaction among Elderlies at Social Institution of Tresna Werdha "Ilomata" Gorontalo. Personality is an internal factor which influences interaction satisfaction. The accomplishment of interaction is manifestation of actualization to promote the expectation of elderly to live at elderly institution. The research aimed at analyzing the relationship between personality type (extrovert and introvert) and satisfaction level of interaction among elderlies at Social Institution of Tresna Werdha "Ilomata" Gorontalo.

The research applied analytic descriptive method through the application of cross sectional design. population was elderlies who live at Social Institution of Tresna Werdha "Ilomata" Gorontalo while total sampling determined 33 people to become samples. Data were obtained by questionnaire.

the result showed that : (1) there were elderlies who had extrovert personality amounted to 42,4% while introvert personality amounted to 57,6% at Social Institution of Tresna Werdha "Ilomata" Gorontalo. (2) There were elderlies who had level of satisfaction "sufficient" amounted to 17 people or 51,5%, "satisfactory" amounted to 12 people or 36,4%, and less satisfactory" amounted to 4 people or 12,1%.

To sum up, through the application of non parametric kolmogorov smirnow test, it obtained significance value as  $p = 0,0000$  which verified there was significant relationship between personality type (intorvert and extrovert) and satisfaction level of interaction among elderlies at Social Institution of Tresna Werdha "Ilomata" Gorontalo.
