Conclusion

There are ten teaching reading problems faced by the teachers in planning and preparation and lesson presentation. They are (a) the content, methods and structures of the selected lesson were not appropriate for the pupil in intended learning, (b) materials, resources and aids were not well prepared and checked in good time, (c) all planning decision cannot take the account of the pupils and the context, (d) the teacher's manner was not confident, relaxed, self-assured, purposeful, and not generating the interest in the lesson, (e) the teacher's instructions and explanations were not clearly matched to pupils' needs, (f) the teacher's questions including a variety of types and not range and were not distributed widely, (g) pupils were not actively involved in the lesson and were not give opportunities to organize their own work, (h) the teacher does not show respect and not encouragement for pupils' ideas, contribution and cannot foster their development (i) the work undertaken by the pupils was not well matched to their needs, and (j) materials, resources and aids were not used to good effect.

The teachers have to know those problems in teaching reading in order they can solve the problems in the future. Besides, to the further researcher have to solve the teacher problems in teaching reading.
