

ABSTRAK

Morning briefing adalah kegiatan yang dilakukan setiap pagi di rumah sakit untuk mengevaluasi pengalaman dan persepsi anggota tim keperawatan dan medis terhadap masalah kesehatan yang terjadi pada pasien melalui komunikasi yang efektif antar anggota tim. Disiplin adalah kepatuhan terhadap peraturan atau tunduk pada pengawasan, dan pengendalian. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan *Morning briefing* dengan tingkat disiplin perawat di ruang interna RSUD Prof. Dr. H. Aloei Saboe Kota Gorontalo.

Desain penelitian yang digunakan adalah *Survey Analitik* dengan menggunakan pendekatan study *Cross Sectional*. Populasi dalam penelitian ini berjumlah 53. Teknik pengambilan sampel *Accidental Sampling*, sampel penelitian berjumlah 45. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa perawat dengan *morning briefing* baik 75,6% dan *morning briefing* kurang baik 24,4% dengan tingkat disiplin baik 75,6% dan disiplin kurang baik 24,4%. Analisa data menggunakan *Chi Square* dengan nilai *P value* 0,000. Terdapat hubungan bermakna antara *morning briefing* dengan tingkat disiplin perawat di Ruang Interna RSUD Prof. Dr. H. Aloei Saboe Kota Gorontalo. Hasil penelitian ini diharapkan dapat memberikan informasi tambahan kepada perawat agar selalu melakukan evaluasi kegiatan melalui *morning briefing* sehingga dapat meningkatkan kedisiplinan dalam menjalankan tugas sebagai seorang perawat.

ABSTRACT

Morning briefing is an activity done each morning at hospital to evaluate the experience and perception of nursing team and medical members toward health problem occurred on patients through effective communication between members of team. Discipline is the obedience toward the rules or monitoring and control. This research aimed at investigating the relation between morning briefing with the level of nurses' discipline at intern room of RSUD Prof. Dr. H. Aloei Saboe Gorontalo City.

The research design in this research was analytical survey with cross sectional study approach. The population of research were 53. The samples were 45 gained by Accidental Sampling. The research result showed that nurses with good morning briefing was 75,6% and poor morning briefing was 24,4%, nursing with good discipline was 75,6% and bad discipline was 24,4%. The data analysis by using Ch Square gained P value as 0,000. There was a significant relation between morning briefing and discipline level of nurses at intern room of RSUD Prof. Dr. H. Aloei Saboe Gorontalo City. This research result is expected to give information to the nurses in order to continuously conduct the activity evaluation through morning briefing so that they can improve their discipline and carry out their job as nurses.
