Conclussion

metaphor is figure of speech that saying the one is another or A is B and B is A. There are two classification of metaphor based on larson, namely dead and live metaphor. Dead metaphor are those which are part of construction of lexicon of language. When they are used, the person who listeners or reads does not think about the primary sense of the words, but only the idiomatic sense in directly. The dead metaphor is commonly defined as a metaphor which has lots its metaphorical sense. While, live metaphor are those which are constructed on the spot by the author or speaker to teach illustrate. It is one which is understood only after paying special anttention to the comparison which is being made.

The each meaning that included in Emily Dickinson poems have linkages between other poems, its because of the researcher analyzed in this research about love poem.
