

ABSTRAK

Pengetahuan perawat tentang prinsip etik keperawatan sangat penting pada penerapan prinsip etik keperawatan dalam pemberian asuhan keperawatan pada pasien agar dapat meningkatkan kepuasan dan kepercayaan antar perawat, pasien, dan petugas kesehatan lain. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui gambaran tingkat pengetahuan perawat tentang prinsip etik keperawatan di RSUD Toto Kabila.

Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif dengan pendekatan kuantitatif. Sampel dalam penelitian ini sebanyak 127 responden dengan teknik pengambilan sampel *Proportional stratified Sampling*. Instrumen penelitian menggunakan kuesioner. Hasil penelitian tingkat pengetahuan perawat di RSUD Toto Kabila ditinjau dari 8 prinsip etik keperawatan *autonomy, non-maleficence, beneficence, veracity, justice, confidentiality, fidelity* dan *accountability* terkategori baik. Kesimpulannya tingkat pengetahuan seluruh responden tentang prinsip etik keperawatan di RSUD Toto Kabila terkategori baik.

ABSTRACT

Ansar Katili, Drs., M.Kes.**

Nurse knowledge on the ethical principles in nursing is pivotal in the implementation of nursing care at patients so that it can improve satisfaction and trust among nurses, patients, and other health workers. The research objective was to find out the description of nurse knowledge level on the ethical principles in nursing at RSUD Toto Kabila.

The research applied a quantitative method with a descriptive approach. The research samples were 127 respondents that were obtained through Proportional Random Sampling. The research instrument was questionnaires. Finding of research found that the nurse knowledge level at RSUD Toto Kabila reviewed 8 ethical principles in nursing, which were autonomy, non-maleficence, beneficence, veracity, justice, confidentiality, fidelity, and accountability were categorized as good.

In conclusion, the knowledge level of all respondents on the ethical principles in nursing at RSUD Toto Kabila was categorized as good. As a suggestion, the hospital is expected to improve the knowledge on the ethical principles in nursing, particularly for non-maleficence, beneficence, veracity, and confidentiality.
