This research aims to find out (1) Whether the implementation of *Collaborative Strategic Reading (CSR)* increase the students' achievement in reading comprehension at the students of MA Al-Huda Gorontalo. (2) Which aspects of reading get the highest increase in the implementation of *Collaborative Strategic Reading (CSR)*. This research conducts quantitatively which used pre-experimental research. The sample of this research is 20 students of the second grade at MA Al-Huda Gorontalo. Reading comprehension test, specifically exposition text is used to collecting the data. The test was an objective test and it used to collecting the data pre-test and the post-test. The result of the pre-test was 261 and the post-test was 341. The hypothesis found that the $T_{\text{count}} \geq T_{\text{list}}$ by the value $9,756 \geq 2,093$. It proves that the Hypothesis (H_1) is accepted. Thus, the conclusion is the Collaborative strategic reading (CSR) increases the students' reading comprehension at MA Al-Huda kota Gorontalo.

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui (1) apakah penerapan *Collaborative Strategic Reading (CSR)* dapat meningkatkan kemampuan membaca pemahaman siswa di MA Al-Huda Gorontalo.
