This sense of isolation is clearly illustrated in Salva, when he was in the refugee camp at Ifo, at that time he was following a program formed by the American government where refugees who do not have families can apply and submit their self-information to be able to elected to be adopted by adoptive parents from America and will live there with them. "Most of the people were white; beginning at the airport in Frankfrut, Salva had seen more white people in the last few hours than he had seen before in his whole lifetime" "He tried not to stare, but he couldn't help stuyig the families closely." (A Long Walk to Water, page 65) This situation, illustrates that Salva experienced culture shock when he went to meet his adoptive parents on the plane to Rochester he saw many white people during his trip. This situation makes him feel uncomfortable and feel different, so he starts to produce a sense of isolation where he starts to feel an uncertainty or doubt about his own identity, because being different amidst the majority of people with different races is not easy, especially Salva is not used to be in a situation like this. In addition, from the sentence "He tried not to stare" (A Long Walk to Water, page 65) justifies the culture shock that Salva experienced, where he tried To not forget the plot & setting otherwise, reader can not follow gover analysist!
