

STUDENTS' PERCEPTION ON THE TEACHING VOCABULARY THROUGH SONG

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

In this chapter, some topics related to the issue was discussed they are research background, research question, research aims, scope of research, research objective, previous study, significance of research, and term terminology.

Research Background

Vocabulary is the most important factor that students must master in learning a foreign language because it is the foundation for other language components such as pronunciation, spelling, meaning and grammar. Therefore, because vocabulary as a foundation in language learning can improve student's vocabulary mastery, vocabulary becomes a priority in education. Longman in Septiani (2010) explained that vocabulary is list of words, usually in alphabet order and with explanation of their meaning, less complete than dictionary. It means that they should understand the meaning. Rai (2010, p. 112) mentions vocabulary is a list of words, usually given in alphabetical order. Speaking of technical vocabulary, medical vocabulary and legal vocabulary to mean the list of words needed to describe concepts in that subject and used for discourse in that subject. Vocabulary also means the stock of words used by a person.

Along with the advancement of science and technology in this increasingly globalized era, it cannot be denied that the ability to speak foreign languages, especially English is very important. This also happened in the school that had been observed by the researcher, the pre-observation was conducted at SMA Negeri 1 Paleleh it was found that the problems experienced by students in

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remembering and understanding vocabulary. They easily forget new words taught by the teacher, and sometimes they cannot remember how to pronounce them. Lack of oral practice that is applied in the classroom, thus make students learn vocabulary only taught by the teacher, and lack of media used in the process of understanding and increasing vocabulary for students. Thus problem of students' vocabulary in English is generally influenced by various factors, including the lack of knowledge of students about vocabulary, not using English vocabulary learning media that are attractive to students, and not implementing a proper learning model.

In fact, students need something whether it is a media or a method that can make them interested in learning vocabulary. Now days, there are many types of media that can be used to teach vocabulary to students, one of them is song. It is supported by Lenka (2011:21) stated that using songs in language classroom is highly motivational and effective media in learning a foreign language.

Based on the problem above, it is necessary to carry out an innovation or media as a way out to solve this vocabulary problem in students. The researcher found that on the solutions related to the vocabulary problem of students is song as a media and an option to motivate students, especially in mastering vocabulary. According to Nurkhaeni (2010) by using English songs in teaching vocabulary, students can easily understand and memorize new vocabulary. This expert opinion's is also supported by Burhayani (2013) which also argues that effectiveness can be achieved because songs help students to enjoy the learning process and make it easy for students to remember new words. Sing songs and

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doing activities in the song let students know what new lyrics or words mean without asking other people or looking for them in the dictionary. The use of song as a media to solve vocabulary problems also provides benefits for teacher, so that teacher can be more varied in teaching English while still referring to the curriculum 2013 where songs are one of the teaching topics in grade XII that have been implemented in SMA Negeri 1 Paleleh.

The application of songs as a media is also beneficial for students because of the vocabulary that is quickly memorized, can be remembered for a long time, can generate joy for students, and they can be done even when they are not in the learning process. It is supported by the previous study conducted by Ance Yohanna who is conducted a research about the students' perception on the use of English songs towards English vocabulary. On the result she found that song is a beneficial media to teach about vocabulary to students because the students' vocabulary improving well by teaching vocabulary through song.

On the basis thought above, the researcher is interested to conduct a research entitled "Students' perception on the Teaching of Vocabulary through Song at SMA Negeri 1 Paleleh Grade XII "

Research Question

Based on the research background above, the researcher formulates the research question as follow: What is the students' perception in teaching vocabulary through song at SMA Negeri 1 Paleleh?

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Research Aims

Students
